Day 1 KLIA - Beijing

(MOB/D)

Day 2 Beijing

Visit **Tian An Men Square** in the morning, which is the largest city square in the world, bordered by the Great Hall of the People and Chairman Mao's Mausoleum. Then tour to the **Forbidden City**, the complex of imperial palace, which was home to the Emperors for over 500 years. Grand halls and courts gradually give way to more intimate domestic quarters, giving an insight into the pampered isolation of the emperors. The first place to go in the afternoon is **Niujié Mosque** -- the oldest Mosque with over one thousand year's history. **Dzohor** and **Asar** prayers here. Stop by at **Muslim Supermarket** which is the only supermarket for Muslims in Beijing. We will have a **Foot Massage** at the **Chinese Traditional Medicine Center** (also called **Herbal Medicine Center**). Enjoy a fabulous tea ceremony at the **Tea House**. Dinner at the most famous **Xin Jiang Muslim Restaurant**

Day 3 Beijing

(B/L/D)

Today is the highlight of our China tour, the climbing of the **Great Wall of China**. First built in the Warring States period (475-221BC) as a series of earthworks erected by individual kingdoms as a defense against each other as well as from invasions from the north, the wall we see in the present day was left from the Ming dynasty. Lunch at a local Muslim restaurant near the Great Wall. Shopping at the **Jade & Crystal Shop**. Then visit the **Burning Cream Centre**. We will spend the evening at the **Wang Fu Jing Shopping Street** and its **Night Food Market**, where you will see a collection of Halal snacks.

Day 4 Beijing

(B/L/D)

The **Summer Palace** starts our first program today. Being the largest imperial garden in China, the Summer Palace was first built in the Qing emperor Qianlong's time in 1751 and burned down in 1860 by the French and British army and restored by the Dowager empress Cixi for her own enjoyment. It became a favorite haunt of Cixi, who preferred it to the Forbidden City, and named it Yihe Yuan meaning the garden of health and harmony. Pray at the Ming dynasty-built **Nan Dou Ya Mosque** after lunch - a Mosque with unique Chinese style & hundreds years of history. We will spend sometime at the most famous **Silk Store** - the right place to buy silk products of the best quality. Shopping at **Fresh Water Pearl Center**, where the best pearls will be presented. The evening time is for bazaar shopping at **Tianya Hongqiao Market** and **Xiushui Market**, followed by the famous **Hard Rock Cafe Souvenir Shop**

Day 5 Beijing - Home

Photo stop at **Olympic Stadiums** in the morning - the prestigious **Bird's Nest** and **Water Cube**. Then visit at **Olympic Sponsor Jewelry City**. Before heading to the airport for afternoon flight home, there's the last chance of bazaar shopping at **Yangguang Jinjie Market** - one of the most popular markets in Beijing. Transfer to airport after lunch to end the amazing Beijing trip.
