Day 1 KLIA – Beijing (D)

Arrive in Beijing in the afternoon. Check into hotel for rest & refreshment. After dinner is done, we will enjoy the wonderful **Acrobatic Show** at night

Day 2 Beijing (B/L/D)

Morning visit to the **Tian An Men Square** which is the largest city square in the world, bordered by the Great Hall of the People and Chairman Mao's Mausoleum. Then tour to the **Forbidden City**, the complex of imperial palace, which was home to the Emperors for over 500 years. Grand halls and courts gradually give way to more intimate domestic quarters, giving an insight into the pampered isolation of the emperors. Visit **Niujie Mosque** which is the oldest Mosque with over one thousand year's history. **Dzohor and Asar** prayers here. Next, we will have a **Foot Massage** at the **Chinese Traditional Medicine Center** (also called **Herbal Medicine Center**). Enjoy a fabulous tea ceremony at the **Tea House**. Dinner at the most famous **Xin Jiang Muslim Restaurant**

Day 3 Beijing (B/L/D)

Today is the highlight of our China tour, the climbing of the **Great Wall of China**. First built in the Warring States period (475-221BC) as a series of earthworks erected by individual kingdoms as a defense against each other as well as from invasions from the north, the wall we see in the present day wall was left from the Ming dynasty. Lunch at a local Muslim restaurant near the Great Wall. Shopping at the **Jade & Crystal Shop**. Visit to **Burning Cream Centre**. The evening time will be spent at the **Wang Fu Jing Shopping Street** and its **Night Food Market**, where you will see a collection of Halal snacks.

Day 4 Beijing (B/L/D)

Today's trip starts from the **Summer Palace**. Being the largest imperial garden in China, the Summer Palace was first built in the Qing emperor Qianlong's time in 1751 and burned down in 1860 by the French and British army and restored by the Dowager empress Cixi for her own enjoyment. It became a favorite haunt of Cixi, who preferred it to the Forbidden City, and named it Yihe Yuan meaning the garden of health and harmony. After lunch we will visit one of the most famous mosques in this city, the Ming dynasty-built **Nan Dou Ya Mosque**, who is famous for the unique Chinese style & history of hundreds of years. Head to **Silk Store** after lunch, where the most exquisite silk products will be presented. Shopping at the **Fresh Water Pearl Center**, then go back to hotel after dinner is done.

Day 5 Beijing (B/L/D)

Here comes the day for bazaar shopping. The beautiful morning will be taken by the famous **Hard Rock Cafe Souvenir Shop**, followed by **Muslim Supermarket** – the only supermarket for Muslims in Beijing. After a well catered Halal lunch, we will head to the most popular **Xiushui Market & Tianya Hognqiao Market**. Back to hotel for rest in the evening.

Day 6 Beijing – Home (B/L)

Photo stop at **Olympic Stadiums** in the morning – the prestigious **Bird's Nest** and **Water Cube**. Then visit at **Olympic Sponsor Jewelry City**. Before heading to the airport for afternoon flight home, there's the last chance of bazaar shopping at **Yangguang Jinjie Market** – one of the most popular markets in Beijing. Transfer to airport after lunch to end the amazing Beijing trip.
